Residents have identified the following City service priorities:

- ✓ Maintaining 911 medical emergency response
- ✓ Maintaining fire response
- ✓ Maintaining police response
- ✓ Protecting local drinking water sources

- ✓ Helping prevent property crimes and retail thefts
- ✓ Keeping public beaches clean
- ✓ Keeping public areas clean and safe





Maintaining Emergency Services



- Residents have indicated emergency medical services are a top priority. So far this year alone, approximately 75 percent of all calls to the Orange County Fire Authority that serves Seal Beach have been related to medical emergencies.
- The City must be able to ensure that our city has the needed firefighters and paramedics, and lifesaving equipment to maintain emergency response times and save lives.






Community members have indicated it is a top priority to keep our community safe.

Unfortunately, despite the city's best efforts last year, there were over 700 thefts, burglaries, robberies, and auto thefts in the City of Seal Beach—the highest number in five years. The City must maintain public safety and community policing efforts to keep residents and their property safe.



Maintaining the Basics


