SEAL BEACH COOLING CENTER WILL OPEN THIS WEEK

Seal Beach, CA – As a result of the anticipated warmer temperatures this week, the City of Seal Beach will open a cooling center. The cooling center will be open Monday, August 24th, 2026 through Friday, August 28th, 2026, and reevaluated based on temperatures for the weekend.

Hours of Operation: 8:00 am to 9:00 pm

Amenities: Air Conditioning, Water, Television, Tables and Chairs

Residents are encouraged to take preventative steps to stay safe during periods of extreme heat. Drink plenty of water throughout the day, even if you do not feel thirsty, and limit strenuous outdoor activities during the hottest parts of the day. Wear lightweight, light-colored clothing, use sunscreen when outdoors, and seek air-conditioned spaces when possible.

Residents should also check on family members, friends, neighbors, and others who may be more vulnerable to extreme heat, including older adults, young children, and those who may not have access to air conditioning. **Never leave children or pets unattended in a parked vehicle.**

For those without access to air conditioning, the city encourages residents to take advantage of the Seal Beach Cooling Center during its hours of operation.

Residents are also encouraged to stay informed by signing up for **Nixle** and **AlertOC**, which provide emergency notifications and important public safety information. Nixle provides alerts and updates from the Seal Beach Police Department. To sign up, residents can visit Nixle.com or text their ZIP code to **888777**. AlertOC delivers emergency notifications from Orange County related to significant incidents, including severe weather and other hazards. Residents can register at AlertOC.com or text **AlertOC** to **888777** to sign up for Orange County emergency alerts.
